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#### Objectives of Sports Funding spending for 2015 / 16

To raise the participation and enjoyment of various sporting activities within school by:

- Achieving the Silver Kite Mark from School Games
- Increase the level of specialist coaches to introduce a more varied and challenging sporting curriculum and activities
- To provide further opportunities for children to access sporting competitions
- Improvement in the variety of; and access to, extra-curricular activities, such as after school clubs and resources.
- Increase awareness of the external clubs and community sports activities available and offer 'taster' sessions within school
- Installing more outdoor activity equipment to encourage all children to be active

#### Summary of expenditure

- Increased Involvement with specialist PE/Sport coaches and teachers
- Access to a wider variety of general and specialist sporting activities and games
- Provide resources and training courses in PE and Sporting activities
- Attendance of training and meetings to update staff knowledge
- Organising and running sports clubs and competitions, both internal and external, and after school clubs
- Transport for sporting opportunities and competitions
- Purchasing additional kit and equipment to ensure all children are able to participate
- Sports field and hall markings to accommodate a variety of activities
- Purchasing larger outdoor equipment and fitness apparatus

#### Impact of SFG spending

- School Games Kitemark gained – bronze level.
- Staff have developed ideas and increased confidence in planning for dance lessons due to CPD in lesson support from specialist coach
- Maintained participation in Level 1 (school), Level 2 (cluster/ town) and Level 3 (regional) competitions.
- Continued variety of after school sports offered – boys football/ girls' football/ gymnastics / salsa dancing/ orienteering/ Fitness Fun
- Higher profile of PE throughout the school more children are attending outside clubs
- Football - Y4 girls won the Y4 Football Tournament

- **Achieved a Bronze medal in Y6 boys long jump at the Town Sports event.**
- **Equipment purchased for breaktimes to encourage children to be active in their spare time**
- **Change for Life Club (Fitness Fun Club) continued to thrive.**
- **Continued use of coaches to teach specific and more varied PE lessons – games, athletics, target sports, rackets sports, archery, tennis, football, netball, ball skills, street dance and cricket**
